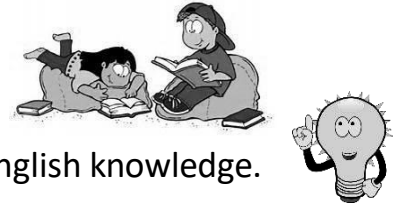


Shalom to all my fellow 8th grade Advanced English students who are going up to 9th grade next year,

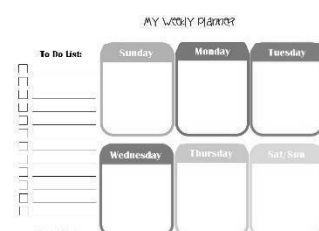
or borrow from someone who has an English library at home

- B. Write a paragraph about the author and why he/she wrote the novel?
- C. What time period was the novel written in? Describe that period of time. What was it like for society then?
- D. Write three paragraphs summarizing the book in your own words
1. First paragraph – beginning of the story
 2. Second paragraph – The middle of the story leading up to the climax.
 3. Third paragraph - The climax and resolution/ conclusion of the story.

When we return to school in September you will have an in-class assignment where you will complete E and F in class. **Bring your assignment of A, B, C, & D completed and printed, along with your book in order to continue parts E & F.**
